Awesome electric guitar players are always upping their game with both personal rehearsal, and gear that “does the trick” for certain sounds. They get beyond “toys” and learn from better players in the worship genre what gear serves what sound best.

Awesome electric guitar players are always listening to the rest of the band, seeking to play just enough to add something to the overall sound. They know how to lay out, add a wash, be sound effects, or play a straight-up rhythm or lead part.

Awesome electric guitar players ask the worship leader what kind of sound he/she wants for each song. They seek to be seamless in creating that sound, because they practice and prepare outside of rehearsal according to the recordings of the songs. They also regularly tune as they play.
